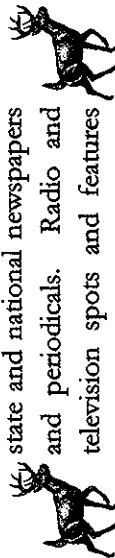


WELCOME TO PINE APPLE

Each year the Les Moorer Memorial Big Buck Contest is held as a featured event of Hunter Appreciation Day. There are three divisions: Big Buck Winner, Ladies, and Juveniles. A \$500 cash prize will be awarded for the top prize. \$250 will be awarded for the women's division and the Juvenile Division for age 17 and younger will collect \$150. The deer must be killed on the day of the event and a \$20.00 entry fee is required. All



entries are due before 8:00 p.m. Friday, November 23rd. The Buckmaster's scoring system is used. All paid entries will receive a FREE Hunter Appreciation Day T-Shirt. The T-shirts will be available at the Friday night BBQ or Saturday at the Pine Apple Promotions booth. Final judging will be at 6:45 and prizes awarded at 7 p.m.

Antique Car Parade:

No entry fee is required for this favorite event of the day. Trophies will be awarded in 4 categories. Line up is 11:00 a.m. at the historic Moore Academy School and the parade begins at 12 noon.

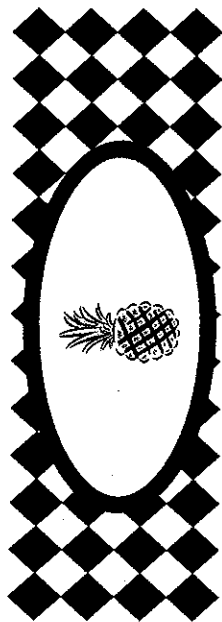
